Prohibitions of Extremist Views

Whilst the Trust condemn all acts of aggression against Muslims around the world and strive against this, we do NOT believe terrorism, extremism or other acts of a similar nature are the correct way to solve these problems

We believe the message of Islam is to be spread by the exemplary, peaceful nature of Muslims and it is through this message of Islamic and diplomacy that we can improve the lives of all people in the world.

Rules

The Trust prohibits the endorsement of any extremist or terrorist views. Any such views expressed on Trust premises or by any attendees or any individuals are not to be considered representative of the Trust.

There is a complete ban by the Trust on any material or talks which could be construed as endorsing extremist or terrorist views, this includes lectures, adverts for talks at other venues, books, leaflets, pamphlets or other media being distributed, made available or endorsed on Trust premises.

If such views are being expressed and the committee is made aware then actions will be taken to stop this immediately.

To facilitate this, any material displayed at the Trust premises, or any talks held there or any material distributed there should have been vetted by the Trust committee. Speaker guests may be asked to provide a summary of their planned speech in advance.

Staff

All Staff at the Trust including teachers, assistants, volunteers as well as committee members and trustees shall agree to abide by the conditions above. They shall also be obliged to inform the committee if they become aware of anyone else breaking these rules.

We also expect them to declare all current, past and future affiliations with any organisations especially political or religious ones. Any associations with groups or organisations or even members of organisations on any government terrorist watch list, or any group or organisation that promotes terrorism is strictly forbidden either when attending Trust business, or in their personal life.

Any breach of these rules will be a disciplinary matter the usual consequence of which shall be instant dismissal.
